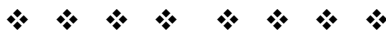




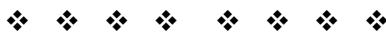
How Can Your Practice Learn More About Developmental Concerns?

What is the Concerned About Development Learning Collaborative (CADLC)?

- The CADLC works with Ohio communities to find children with developmental problems early, by teaching best practices in screening and referral.
- Your team will learn a system of care that uses new, practical, Ohio AAP backed developmental screening tools.
- Your team will learn how to bill for developmental screening.
- Your team will meet with local service providers to better coordinate care.
- Your team will receive recognition and support from Ohio AAP and its partners.
- The first 100 practices to sign up will receive \$450 of free screening tools.
