I would first like to thank all the trainers who took time on Wednesday, Dec.14 to attend MOBI's first webinar. It looks like more than half the trainers were able to attend and we were able to cover a number of changes in a very short time. Karen will be sending out the updated forms beginning with all MOBI packages going out in January, and the forms will also be available on the MOBI website to download and copy. Please plan on introducing these starting with any program after Jan. 1, 2012.

MOBI TTT Workshop: Thank you to the new MOBI trainers who attended the September 2011 MOBI Train-the-Trainer Workshop for new trainers.

Please visit the website throughout the year and prior to upcoming MOBI presentations, to find the latest MOBI resources that may have missed our resource print deadlines for inclusion into the resource packs.

Summary of Updated MOBI Materials as of September 2011. These materials may be used through March 2012.

- 1) **Slides** - The slide set now contains 49 slides, as compared to the previous 50 slide set. One slide, the multi-vaccine VIS slide (slide 44), was removed. The multi-vaccine

VIS topic is now added to slide 43 as an additional bullet point. The overall slide set's layout has been enhanced with bolded subheadings for improved visibility and clarity.

- 2) **Presenter's notes** - The presenters' notes have been updated with new information and layout changes for easier reading on 32 out of the 49 slides.
- 3) **Clinical Disease Slides** - This optional slide set of clinical disease slides have increased by one slide from 17 slides to 18 slides, with the addition of a Rubella slide. We've added an audio file of a pertussis cough to the pertussis slide (slide 2), so that participants will hear the classic pertussis cough with the click of a horn icon embedded under the pertussis image. Additional images of measles, Varicella, and Rubella rashes have been added to the presentation.

September 2011 slide changes include:

Slide 2 Continuing Education – Note section updated with guidance on what to do when the program lasts less than the required 60 minutes.

Slide 3 Case – Key point added to note section

Slide 5 Topics – Note section reorganized for easier reading and guidance added to help trainer introduce the topics covered and expectations during the presentation.

Slide 9 MOBI Resource Pack – Key point revised and guidance given on incorporating the resource pack into the presentation.

Slide 10 Office Resource Pack – “Brochures” added to slide content list.

Slide 11 Immunization Schedule – Note section expanded with schedule facts

Slide 12 Recommended vs. Required – Subtitles bolded for clarity

Slide 13 What's new in the 2011 schedule? – Slide changed to only show MCV4 recommendations.

Slide 14 What's new in the 2011 Schedule? – Slide changed to show only Tdap recommendations. Presenter notes reflect this change.

Slide 15 Schedule – Notes changed to add a sentence identifying schedule as the 2011 Recommended Immunization Schedule.

Slide 16 Adolescent Schedule – Notes updated with additional schedule detail

Slide 18 Catch-up Schedule – Notes updated with statement that a vaccine series does not have to be restarted regardless of the time that has elapsed between doses.

Slide 19 Minimum Age/Interval – Notes updated to identify MMR, Varicella, MMRV, and LAIV as live vaccines.

Slide 20 Reviewing Immunization Records – Slide subtitles bolded for clarity. Notes reorganized into sections for easier review. Added line - ‘Nonstandard routes may increase adverse reactions’.

Slide 22 Ohio Immunization Rate – Added line to Graph- ‘Goal-90% or higher’.

Slide 26 Office Strategies – Slide bullet points 1-5 edited with active verbs for each strategy listed. Notes reorganized for easier reading. Key point added to notes.

Slide 27 Three Steps – Slide subtitles bolded for clarity.

Slide 28 Valid reasons to withhold a vaccine – Slide subtitles bolded for clarity. Note section reformatted for easier review.

Slide 29 Screen for contraindications and precautions – Slide modified with 4th bullet point added - ‘Prevent adverse reactions’

Slide 30 Reduce Office barriers – Slide bullet point modified for clarity to ‘Give nurses authority to immunize by using standing orders’

Slide 31 Immunization Reminder & Recall – Slide title modified with the addition of ‘immunization’ added to title. Notes modified by adding ‘immunization’ to reminder/recall description.

Slide 32 Reminder& recall – Slide subtitle changed - removed ‘(Ohio’s registry)’

Slide 33 IMPACT SIIS – Notes IMPACT SIIS definition added.

Slide 34 IMPACT SIIS – Notes updated with paragraph highlighting the benefits of using IMPACT SIIS in an office practice.

Slide 37 VFC – Slide subtitles bolded for clarity.

Slide 39 Influenza Vaccine Options – Slide updated with the 2011-12 Influenza dosing information for children under the age of 9 years. Notes updated to include the 2011-12 Influenza dosing recommendations.

Slide 43 VIS – Slide updated with a 6th bullet point added - ‘Multi vaccine VIS available’

Slide 44 Vaccine Management – Slide updated to include new Varicella temperature guidelines - ‘Varicella vaccines (-58° to 5°F)’

Slide 45 Proper Storage and Handling – Slide updated with a New Temperature log added. New log features sample documentation of both in-range and out of range temperatures.

Slide 47 Program Follow up – Slide updated to show only the 1-month follow-up form.
